COURSE OVERVIEW:

The ENPC provides a two-day review and testing of basic pediatric emergency nursing knowledge. Specific areas of childhood illness and injury are discussed in morning lectures, with skill station testing and a written test the second day. The goal of ENPC is to improve the care of the pediatric patient in the emergency care setting, and to increase the skill and knowledge of the nurse providing that care.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Any RN interested in improving their pediatric emergency nursing skills. It is recommended that participants have a minimum of 6-12 months experience in the emergency setting. Only RN's may participate in the Psychomotor skills stations and the Multiple choice exam.

DO I HAVE TO PREPARE FOR THIS CLASS?

Because this is a course where your knowledge and skills are tested, advance preparation is recommended.

You will receive your manual as soon as registration is received.

WHAT DO I GET WHEN I COMPLETE THE ENPC?

If successful in all testing, ENA will issue you an ENPC provider verification card.

HOW MUCH DOES THE ENPC COST?

The fee for the 2-day course is: \$215
